NOTICE TO BIDDERS FOR REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO MAIN TILE AND LATERAL 2 TILE DRAINAGE DISTRICT 4-118, FRANKLIN AND WRIGHT COUNTIES (PROJECT NO. 7213.14)

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the County Auditor of Franklin County, Iowa, at their office in the Franklin County Courthouse, 12 First Ave. NW, P.O. Box 26, Hampton, Iowa 50441 until 10 a.m., on March 23, 2020, for repairs and improvements to Main tile and Lateral 2 tile of Drainage District 4-118, Franklin and Wright Counties, Iowa. Plans, specifications and form of contract are on file at the offices of the County Auditors and describe the work involved and the conditions under which it is to be performed. Bids will be opened by the Engineer and the Boards of Supervisors of Franklin and Wright Counties (acting District Trustees) at a meeting to be held in the Courthouse of Franklin County at 10 a.m., on March 23, 2020. Said bids will be acted on at a time and date to be determined at said bid opening. Plans and specifications governing the construction of the proposed improvements have been prepared by CGA, 739 Park Avenue, Ackley Iowa; phone 641-847-3273. Copies of the plans and specifications for this project can be downloaded at no charge from www.cga-consultants.com ("Bid Info" tab located in the top right corner) or a printed copy can be obtained by contacting Beeline + Blue at 2507 Ingersoll Ave., Des Moines, IA 50312 or by phone at 515-244-1611. A \$50 refundable deposit is required for all printed plan sets and specifications. The fee is REFUNDABLE, provided the following conditions are met: 1) The plans and specifications are returned to CGA complete and in good usable condition and 2) they are returned to the above address within fourteen (14) calendar days after the award of the project.

The proposed work is located in Sections 21, 29, and 30, Township 92 North, Range 22 West in Franklin County, Iowa and consists of the furnishing of all materials, labor, and equipment to complete the approximate quantities of work, all as described in the plans and specifications and as listed as below. One contract will be provided for all divisions of this project.

The proposed work consists of up to 2 stations of Open Ditch Cleanout; up to 31.7 stations of Open Ditch Construction; up to 2,180 feet of 42" through 15" tile; tile removal; tile abandonment; headwall removal; sheet pile headwall; rip-rap; grouted rip-rap; up to 1,070 feet of 24" through 15" surface drains; up to 1,040 feet of 18" through 12" tile outlets, up to 1,560 feet of 18" through 6" tile extensions; private tile connections; concrete collars; removals; seeding; and other associated work.

All bids must be filed with the County Auditor on or before the time herein stated. All bids shall be made on forms furnished by the Owner's Engineer and contained in the specifications and must be enclosed in a separate sealed envelope and plainly identified. Each proposal shall be accompanied by deposit of cash, bid bond, cashier's or certified check, or a credit union certified share draft, in a separate sealed envelope in a amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid. The certified or cashier's check, if used, shall be drawn on a bank in Iowa or a bank chartered under the laws of the United States or said certified share draft should be drawn on a credit union in Iowa or chartered under

the laws of the United States; and such check or share draft shall be made payable to the Franklin County Auditor as security that if awarded a contract by resolution of said Supervisors, the Bidder will enter into a contract at the prices bid and furnish the required performance and payment bond and certificate of insurance. The deposit of cash shall be retained, certified or cashier's check or certified share draft may be cashed, or the bid bond redeemed, if the Contractor fails to enter into a contract, or fails to provide a certificate of insurance within ten (10) days after the acceptance of his proposal by resolution of the County Supervisors. No bidder may withdraw a bid within sixty (60) days after the date set for opening bids. If awarded, one (1) contract will be awarded to the lowest, responsive bidder for all divisions of the Base Bid or Alternate Bid.

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a performance and payment bond, with sureties approved by the County Auditor in favor of the Drainage District for the use and benefit of the Drainage District and to all persons entitled to liens for labor or material, in an amount not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price of the work to be done, conditioned for the timely, efficient, and complete performance of his contracts, and the payment, as they become due, of all just claims for labor performed and material used in carrying out the contract. When the contract is executed and the performance bond approved, the certified check, share draft, cash deposited, or bid bond provided with the bid shall be returned to the bidder. The performance bond shall be provided at the time the contract for work is signed.

Payment to the Contractor will be made in monthly estimates of ninety percent (90%) of the work completed during the period as provided in Section 468.100, Code of Iowa. Pursuant to Sections 468.101 through 468.103, the balance will be paid not less than 30 days after acceptance of the work by the County Supervisors acting as Trustees of the Drainage District. All payments to the Contractor shall be made by check or warrants in favor of such contractor on the drainage fund of the District, which if registered and stamped "not paid for want of funds" in accordance with Chapter 468.70 of the Code of Iowa.

The work under the proposed contract shall begin within 15 days of the Notice to Proceed. All work is to be completed by December 31, 2020 including seeding and finishing work. The Contractor shall pay the said District Five Hundred (\$500.00) per day as liquidated damages for each calendar day the work remains uncompleted after the completion date stated above.

The Boards of Supervisors hereby reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive informalities and irregularities as it may deem to be for the best interests of the Drainage District.

Published upon the order of the Boards of Supervisors of Franklin and Wright Counties (acting as District Trustees), who also reserve the right to reject any or all proposals and to waive informalities and technicalities.
