OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS UNAPPROVED MINUTES AUGUST 3, 2020

Be it duly noted these minutes of Aug. 3, 2020 are UNOFFICIAL minutes.

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30 a.m., with Board members Michael Nolte-Chairman, Gary McVicker and Corey Eberling present.

Chairman Nolte led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, approves the Agenda as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Nolte, approves the Minutes of July 27, 2020. All ayes. Motion carried.

Committee Updates: FCDA; Access; Historical Society land request

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, approves an Application to Perform Work Within Franklin County Highway Right-of-Way for Dennis Swieter to cut down backslope and reshape ditch at 944 Mallard Avenue to improve site distance. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Eberling, approves a Road Closure on Eagle Avenue between 170th Street and 190th Street as of 8:30 a.m., on July 30, 2020 for tile crossing. All ayes, motion carried.

The Board discussed DD #48 Field Crossings. Present was: Colette Bruns-Drainage Clerk and Lee Gallentine-Drainage Engineer via Zoom.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Eberling, authorizes Lee Gallentine, CGA Drainage Engineer, to inspect the Lemke/Hackbarth field crossing for repairs

and check the current pipe to see if it is strong enough to hold rather than replace and just look at the Blackford crossing and report back. All ayes. Motion carried.

Travis Gerrish, GIS Coordinator, reported on a Citizen Reporting Tool that is available through an app download. No action taken.

A Departmental Meeting was held via Zoom.

Roger Kregel, Dumont Telephone Company, requested a Letter of Support from the Supervisors stating the current Broadband Internet in the rural areas is not available and Dumont Telephone is interested in investing in the County in designated areas fiber optic.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Eberling, approves a Letter of Support for Dumont Telephone Company to expand 100 Meg fiber optic service on a designated route; west of Geneva to Hwy 65 north to 110th Street west to Olive Avenue. All per the receiving of a Federal Grant. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by McVicker, seconded by Eberling, approves a COVID-19 Prevention Initiative Proclamation for Franklin County, recommending the wearing of masks in public places and social distancing throughout the whole County. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, adjourns at 11:33 a.m., until Aug. 10, 2020. All ayes. Motion carried.
