Chairman Nolte led the Pledge of Allegiance. Motion by McVicker, Seconded by Vanness to approve the Agenda as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve the Board Minutes & Drainage Minutes dated 9/27/21 as presented. All ayes. Motion Carried.

Public Comment & Board Committee Reports: Dan Scheffler & Aaron Chin from Vestas were present to fill the board in on a new windmill project occurring in Richland and Marion townships.

Jay Waddingham, County Engineer, met with the Board and gave an update on his department.

Motion by Vanness, seconded by Nolte to approve the Franklin Co Utility Permit Application for MidAmerican Energy Company to place fiber optic along 110th Street (C47) from Killdeer Ave to Hwy 65 and along Olive Av (S43) from City of Hampton 10th Street to City of Hampton 12th Street and along City of Hampton 12th Street from Olive Ave (S43) to City Limits. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Vanness, Seconded by McVicker to approve the road closure of Nettle Ave between 180th & 190th Street for Bridge Construction/Repair as of 10:15AM on 9/28/21. All ayes. Motion carried.
